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Instructions for Filing 2021 Individual Income Tax Returns

Dear Clients,

Under current law we are now required to electronically file ("E-File") your tax returns. They can no longer be sent by mail. It is important that you read the information below and follow the instructions carefully. Although we will be responsible for e-filing your return, ***the responsibility for paying any tax owed on or before the required due date is yours:***

1. Please review the enclosed taxpayer copy of your 2021 tax returns carefully. This copy is for your file and should not be mailed to any federal or state taxing authority.
2. If you have questions with the return or revisions, please contact our office as soon as possible with these changes.
3. **IF YOU ACCEPT THE RETURN AS ENCLOSED, YOU AND YOUR SPOUSE (IF MARRIED) MUST SIGN THE ENCLOSED FEDERAL AND STATE E-FILE CONSENT FORMS WHERE INDICATED AND RETURN THEM EITHER BY FAX (973-778-0140), BY EMAIL TO DRAMOS@GITTCO.COM OR BY MAIL. A POSTAGE PAID MAILING ENVELOPE IS ENCLOSED FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE. PLEASE NOTE THAT WE CANNOT E-FILE YOUR RETURNS UNTIL WE RECEIVE THE SIGNED CONSENT FORMS BACK.**
4. Once the consent forms are received by our office, we will then arrange to e-file your returns on or before the required due dates. We will receive acknowledgements of filing from the various taxing authorities, which will be kept in your file for safekeeping.
5. If you are receiving refunds, you will receive them within four weeks from the date the returns are e-filed. If you owe taxes or are required to file 2022 estimated taxes, you are responsible for paying these taxes on or before their required due dates in accordance with the enclosed filing instructions and payment vouchers. Again, please note that it is your responsibility to remit these payments. Our responsibility is simply to e-file the returns.
6. Should the federal or state government reject the e-filing, we will immediately contact you and explain the reasons for this rejection. If the exceptions cannot be cleared, you may be required to mail the returns. Should this occur, we will contact you and forward paper copies of the returns for mailing.
